Reporting to the Manager, Seniors and Assisted Living, the Homemaker is responsible for the provision of personal care services to elderly and/or disabled adults to allow them to remain independent in their own residence.

- Managing the client's home environment to mitigate the risk of accidents and potential hazards
- Identify and report on problem areas in the home environment

- Maintain time and assignment sheets for billing purposes
- Promote WWCC values and mission in a positive manner
- Maintain professional working relationships with co-workers
